

Gift Aid Declaration

Only complete this form if you are a UK tax payer.

Gift Aid - Additional notes:

1. You are able to cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the church. It will not then apply to donations made after the date of cancellation.
2. Please notify any change of name or address.
3. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income equal to the tax that the church reclaims, you should cancel your declaration with us immediately.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. Because of the need to identify gifts, payment must be by way of:
 - cash or cheque, using either personally identified envelopes or accompanied by a note clearly showing your name and the amount and date of your gift or
 - by banker's standing order.

"I am a UK taxpayer and understand that if I pay less income tax in a tax year than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all of my donations in that tax year it is my responsibility to pay any difference."
